

Changes For 2009-2010

Student ID's

- All students will be required to wear photo Identification during school and need to present it for school sponsored events.
- Failure to wear proper identification will result in disciplinary action.
- The school will provide one free ID at the beginning of each school year, additional ID's may be purchased for \$5.00 in the event an Id is lost or broken.

Cell Phone Policy

- 1st offense - 1 hour detention
- 2nd offense - Misconduct and parent picks up phone
- 3rd offense - Saturday School
- 4th offense or more - Out of school suspension and parent meeting

Tardy Policy

- 1-2nd offense - Teacher warning
- 3-5th offense - 1 hour detention
- 6th-8th offense - Misconduct
- 9th offense - Saturday School
- 10th offense or more - Out of school suspension, intervention meeting with parent

Electronic Device Policy

- 1st offense - 1 hour detention
- 2nd offense - Misconduct and parent/guardian must pick up phone
- 3rd offense - Saturday School
- 4th offense or more - Out of school suspension, intervention meeting with parent

Progressive Behavior Improvement Plan

- a) Once a student is placed on a progressive behavior improvement plan, any discipline infractions will result in progressive discipline up to and including expulsion.
- b) Once a student reaches the point that they are to be placed on a progressive behavior improvement plan an intervention meeting will be set up with school personnel, the student and a parent/guardian.
- c) When a student is placed on a progressive behavior improvement plan they will be given a staff mentor that will work the student while they are on the behavior improvement plan.
- d) Tardies and Cell Phone violations will not count toward the behavior plan.

Senior Finals

Seniors earning an A or a B third and fourth quarter in a second semester course, may opt out of the final exam if they have do not have any unexcused absences for the 2nd semester. (This includes unverified, skips)

Extra Curricular Activities/Field Trips /After School Activities - Guidelines

Includes dances, field trips, clubs (interact, SADD, student council etc), musical, band/choir performances, sports, all night party etc.

All student's grades will be checked every Friday (through Power School- no academic check is needed). Any student who is failing two or more classes will not be permitted to participate in any extra curricular or after school activities for the following week (Monday-Sunday). A list of ineligible students will be made available to the staff at the end of each Friday.
