- Presentation - Kara Beal & Erin Keyser presented district-wide data review for DIBELS and NWEA
- DIBELS data was presented by Erin for grades K - 5; LLI is taking place in 1st and 2nd grade classrooms and K will begin implementation in January; 16 students currently in Reading Recovery; Target time has been really well-received by the teachers; a specific plan is needed in regard to how students enter/exit intervention

- Kara presented NWEA Fall data for grades K - 11; first year that students took NWEA testing (MAP) that is aligned with Common Core; Kara pointed out that there may be a slight dip in the data since the test has shifted; celebrations included that 95% of students were tested, 7th grade exceeded the national norm data, five grade levels in math exceeded scores from last year; all data presented will be available on Blackboard
