- Monday to Thursday for 3 weeks
- Drive time (12 hrs.) required in addition to class time (24 hrs.)
- In-person class and final exam @ WWACE
- 12:00—2:00 PM
- *Minimum class size: 10 students by Thursday before first class*
- *Maximum class size: 30 students*

Student Eligibility [from Secretary of State website]

- Student must be 14 years and 8 month old.

Segment 2 Classes :: \$75

Available Dates for Segment 2:

- June 19 to 21
- July 10 to 12
- August 14 to 16

General Information for all Segment 2 classes listed above:

- Monday to Wednesday
- In-person class and final exam @ WWACE
- 10:00 AM—12:00 PM
- *Minimum class size: 10 students by Thursday before first class*
- *Maximum class size: 36 students*

Student Eligibility [from Secretary of State website]

- Student must have held a valid Level 1 license for a minimum of 3 consecutive months.
- Student must have completed a minimum of 30 hours of driving time with a parent, legal guardian, or, with the permission of a parent or legal guardian, any licensed driver who is 21 years of age or older. Two of the 30 hours must be night driving. A student must possess a Level 1 license to drive a motor vehicle.
- *To verify enrollment eligibility*, a student may need to present the Segment 1 certificate of completion, the Level 1 driver license, and a driving log or parent certification of the student's driving hours.

Disclaimers & Class Information

- Registration is not complete until the registration form has been filled out in its entirety and the class fee has been paid in full.
- Warren Woods Adult & Community Education is a non-smoking, drug-free zone. Disruptive or unruly participants may be removed from the class without a refund of any or all fees.
- If a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, all tuition will be refunded.
- All refunds must be requested before the 2nd class of the enrolled session or pro-rata in accordance with the Premier Driving Academy contracts will apply.

2. Pay for the class.

- Cash accepted at the Adult & Community Education office [use Door #1] during business hours [8:30 AM to 3:30 PM Monday—Friday].
- Payment by check is only available through PaySchools. Payment by check will not be accepted in the office.

3. Bring your birth certificate to the first class of Segment 1.

Registrations must be received by the Thursday before the first day of class. If the minimum number of students is not met, the class may be cancelled with full refund.

A student is fully registered for the class when the form has been completed and payment made in full.
