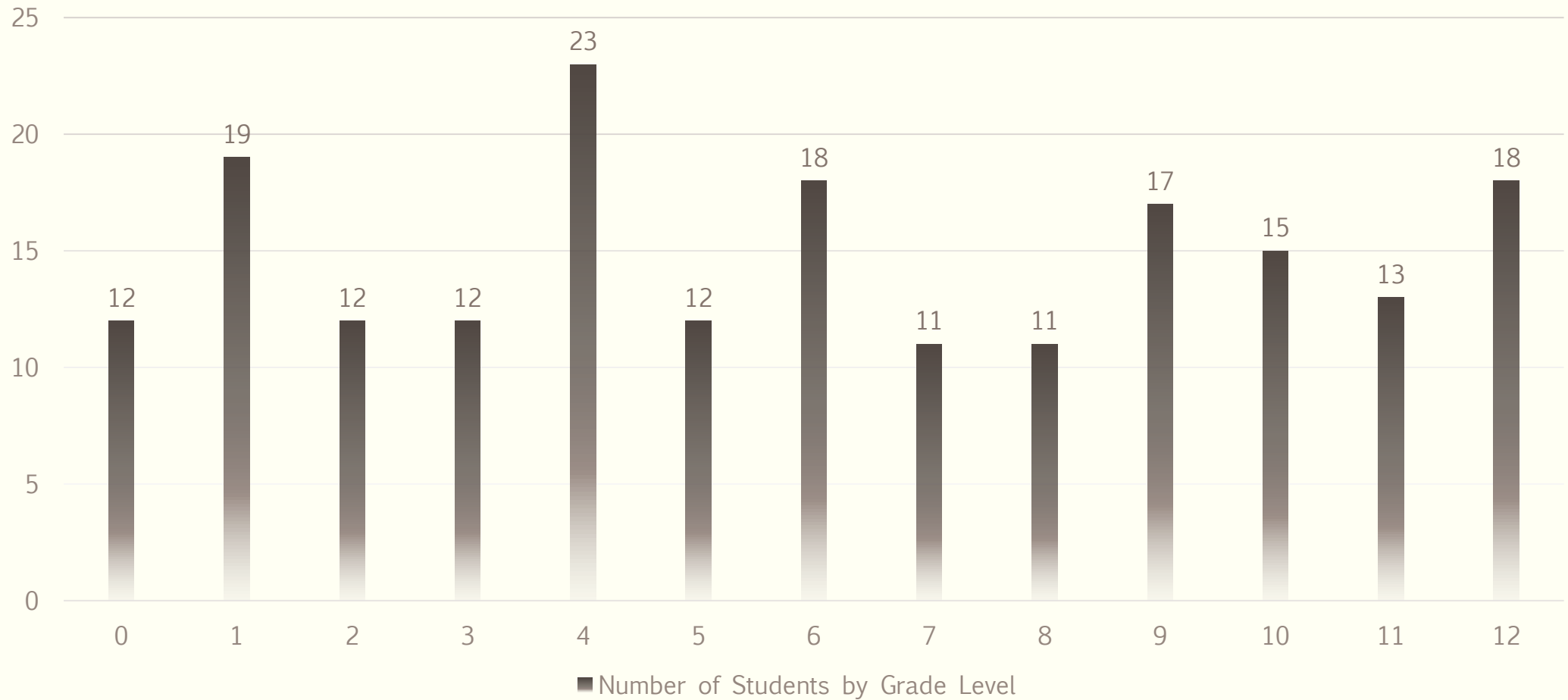

Background Information

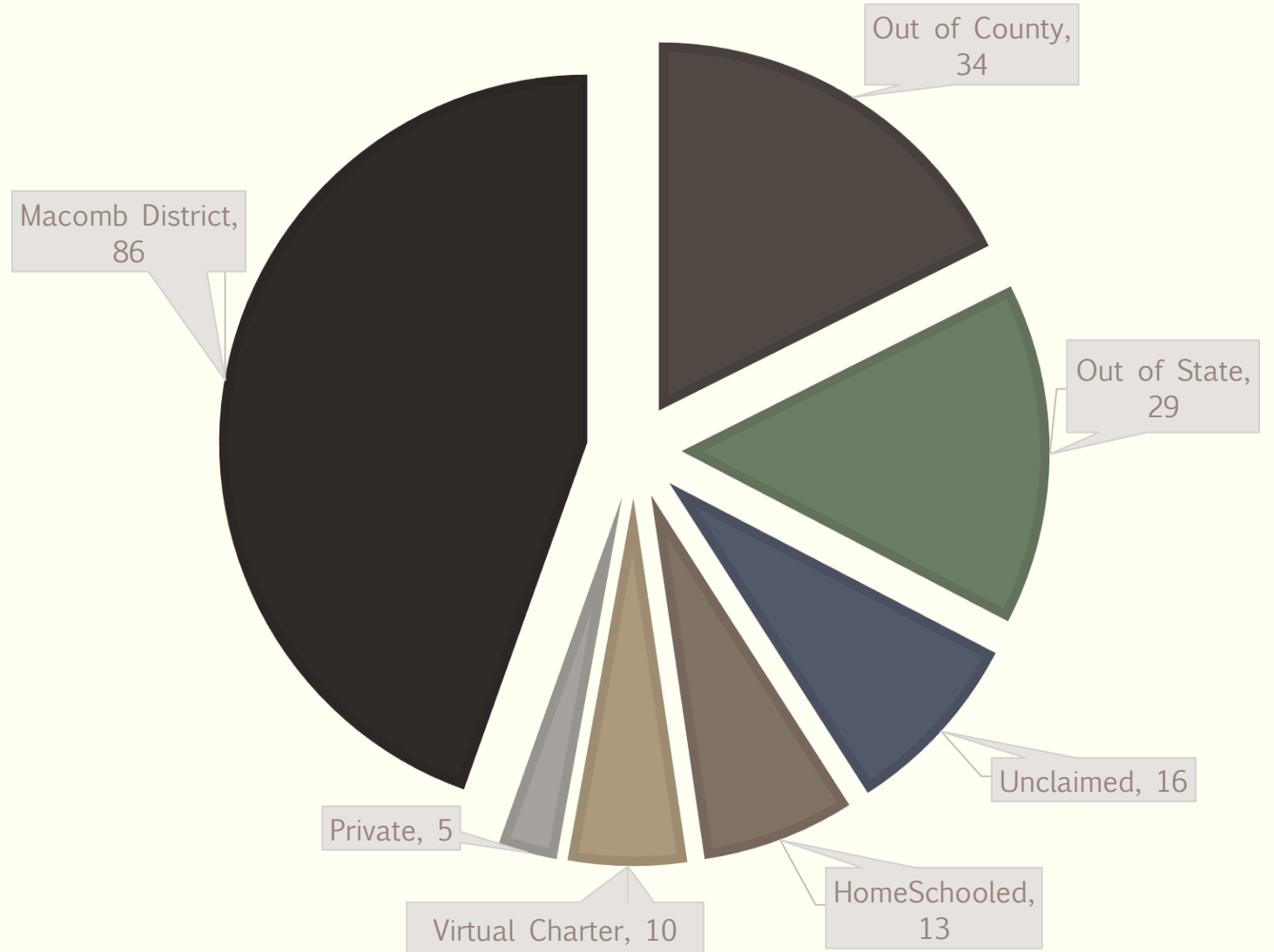
- Spring of 2020 Count = 3,218
- Fall of 2020 Count = 3,163
 - New Registrations combined with Exits
- Total number of new enrollees = 138
- Total number of Exits = 193
- Statewide – Fall enrollment down 53,000
 - Over last 10 years, Michigan Public School population has declined 13,000 students annually
 - 17,000 parents told districts they were going to homeschool in the Fall – that is roughly 14,000 more than the last couple years.
 - Parents are working from home or unemployed.
 - 13,000 fewer Kindergarteners in Fall of 2020
 - Remaining 13,000 unaccounted for in the Fall of 2020

Grade Levels of Students who Exited before Fall Count

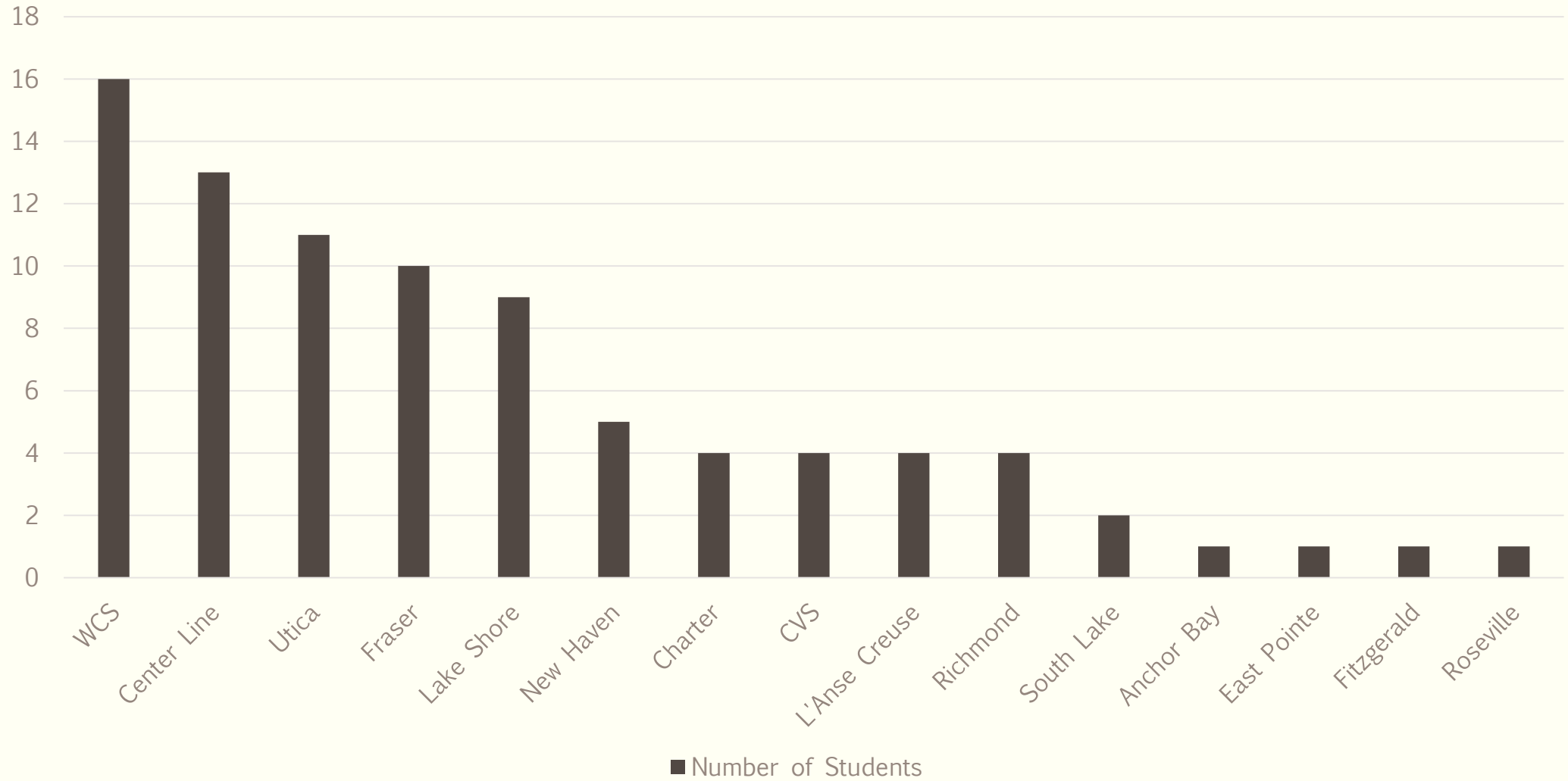


Where Did They Go?

- Majority went to another District in Macomb – 86 students
- 34 students moved out of the county
- 29 students moved out of the state
- 13 chose to homeschool and 10 went to established virtual charter
- Concerned about 16 unclaimed

Next Steps

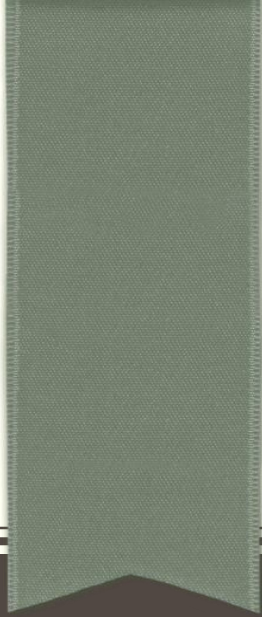
At the change to second semester, we have taken enrollments for at least 10 Warren Woods residents who did not enroll in school for the Fall.

All of those families state they were not ready to send their children back during a pandemic.

None of those new enrollees were from our list of Not Enrolled.

We will continue to call on the 16 students who were not enrolled during Fall count.
