Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Macomb County Health Department (MCHD) has identified a positive case of coronavirus (COVID-19) in student/staff persons at Briarwood Elementary. The MCHD and Warren Woods Public Schools worked closely to identify persons who may have been exposed. **All close contact individuals have been identified. *Your child was not in close contact and should continue to attend school as normal.***

The virus that causes COVID-19 is thought to spread mainly through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks. Spread is more likely when people are in close contact with one another (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes). Illness begins 2 to 14 days after a person is exposed.

The symptoms of COVID-19 can include: fever, cough, shortness of breath, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, runny or stuffy nose, loss of taste or smell, and abdominal pain.

It is extremely important that everyone **monitors for symptoms and complete at-home screening each day** ([Student Screener](#)), including a temperature check, prior to coming to school/work. Please notify the school if your child is exhibiting any symptoms and keep them home until you can see your healthcare provider. If your child has been **exposed to a COVID positive individual outside of school, you must notify the school and quarantine** your child for 10 days following the exposure to the COVID positive person.
