- ▶ Warren Woods Enterprise High School ensures that every child will succeed – failure is not an option.

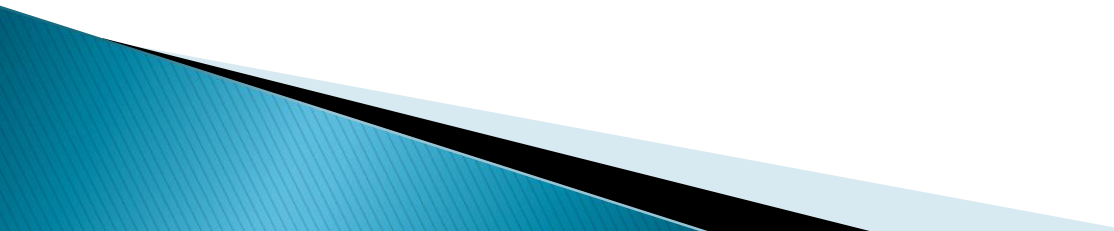


Mission Statement

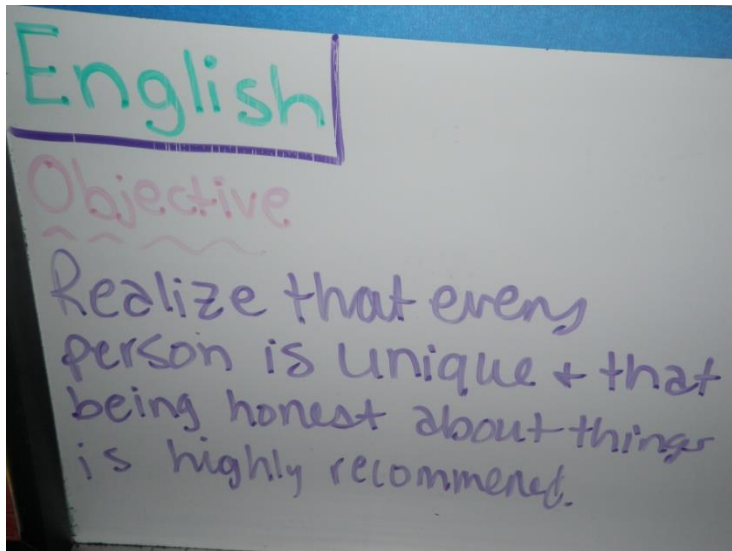
