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Purpose

- To provide students with Tier
 2 intervention during the school day.
- On selected Wednesdays students visit teachers as needed for a 42 minute intervention block to receive one on one help.

Outcomes

- EHS has seen a dramatic increase in passing grades since the waiver started, from 63% in 2011-2012 to 84.5% in 2016-2017.
- Passing grades increased to 88% in the 2017-2018 school year!

Positive Behavior Intervention and Support

The School Improvement team added an additional positive behavior intervention this year with the goal of improving attendance. Students who maintain an 85% class grade or higher, five or less absences, three or less tardies, and no more than three write ups and no suspensions may opt out of taking their quarter exam.
