EHS MAKES A PUSH TO GET GRADS ENROLLED AT MACOMB COMMUNITY COLLEGE

New EHS Principal Mr. George Hamblin knows about competition. One of the state's premiere wrestling coaches, he is running out of fingers on his left hand in which to wear his State Championship rings. Hamblin understands that high expectations, a strong work ethic and a common goal, be it an athletic endeavor or in the classroom, are the building blocks to a healthy and successful community.

Eyeballing a brutally competitive economy, Hamblin understood that EHS grads had to extend their education beyond high school. Hamblin, along with EHS counselor Mr. Jason Nostrant, developed a plan to get as many EHS grads enrolled at Macomb Community College or another academic institution. They held seminars, brought in college representatives, discussed the intricacies of financial aid and took multiple field trips to Macomb Community College. The EHS team knew that establishing a culture that would expose and inform EHS grads about collegiate education could make the transition for these students somewhat easier.

All the hard work resulted in 40 EHS grads enrolling in Macomb Community College. Some students picked other educational or professional training institutions to develop their skills. This program will continue to be fine tuned next year. Another goal for the EHS team is to have some EHS seniors dual enrolled during their final year of high school. This scenario would have a senior finishing his/her high school requirements and taking a college class at MCC.
