Warren Woods Enterprise High School continues to help students learn and earn high school diplomas, and Coordinator Mr. George Hamblin is proud to announce that the total of 53 high school graduates in June, 2017, matches last year’s total (53 EHS graduates in 2016). The Enterprise High School (EHS) six-year average (2012—2017) number of graduates is 44 students.

Five EHS students received EHS scholarships for their books and tuition for college in the fall including Raven Benoit, Joe Dysarczyk, Jonathan Nagy, Nicole Merosu, Justin Williamson. In addition, Jonathan Nagy received an art award from Mrs. Stasinski. Also, Mrs. Jennings awarded scholarships to Makayla Webb-Whiting and Richard White.

OTHER FORMAL ASSESSMENTS THAT WERE USED TO GAUGE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT WERE THE NWEA TESTS IN THE FALL AND SPRING, THE PSAT TEST FOR NINTH AND TENTH GRADERS, AND THE PSAT AND SAT REVIEW TESTS IN DECEMBER.
