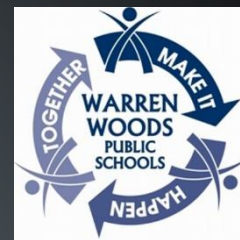

# First Day

- School will begin after Labor Day (Tues. 9/6/22).
- The first bell rings at 8:45 for students to enter their classrooms.
- The official school day begins at 8:50am, it ends at 3:40pm.
- Kindergarten students are to line up by door 5 (front entrance of the Media Center).
- Parents cannot enter the classroom, lobby, or Kindergarten hallway unless they are wearing a volunteer badge and have filled out the volunteer paperwork.
- Student pick up will be at door 5 as well.

# Entering the School Zone

- **Students that Walk**
  - Plan on parking on Bade, Zink or Autumn, and walking on to the school property.
- **Students that take a bus**
  - Prior to the start of school the transportation department will contact you.
  - They will provide you with the pick up location and time your child will be entering/exiting the bus.
  - Busses arrive at the school approximately 8:40 AM.
- **Parking Passes**
  - Parking passes are distributed on a limited basis.
  - Only those with a medical need will be granted permission to drop their student off, or park their car, in the parking lot.



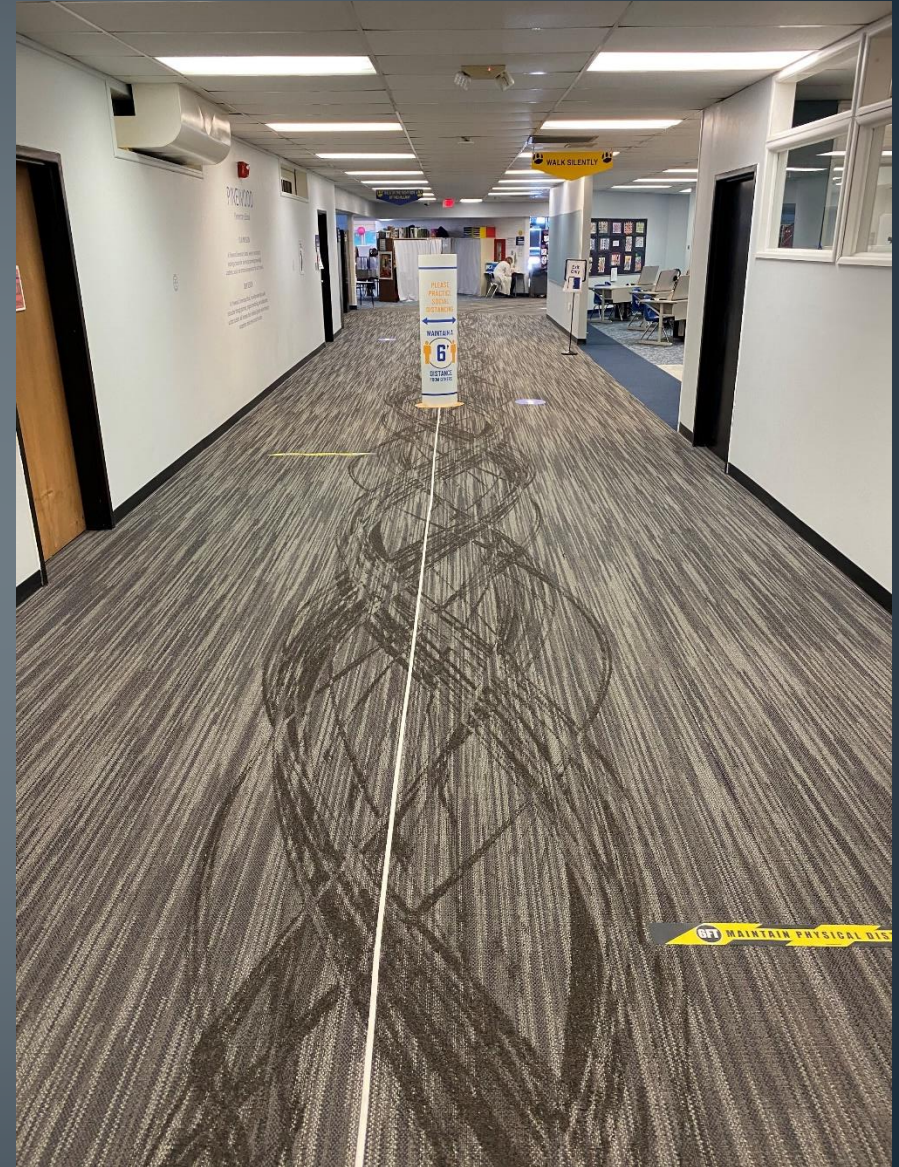

## Enrollment Requirements

Parent or Legal Guardian **must** be present at time of registration.

You must have all the following information before coming into register your student.

	Three (3) Proofs of Residency that reflects parent name, property address, and current date which include <b>One (1) of the following:</b> Current Mortgage Statement Lease Agreement Most Recent Tax Statement <b>Plus</b>
	<b>Two (2) of the following:</b> Current Utility Bill(s) Current Bank Statement Current Credit Card Statement (Any combination of the above) Shut off notices and Intent to Shut off notices will not be accepted
	Original Birth Certificate (with raised seal)
	Immunization record - copies may be obtained through the health department or child's physician.
	Vision and Hearing Screening Test Results
	Parent/Guardian photo ID
	Custody/Guardianship papers (if applicable)
	Residency Affidavits (if applicable)
	Schools of Choice application (if applicable)

Note: Copies will be made of the above documents. You will receive all originals back at the time of enrollment.

# Other Important Office Information

- **Medical Action Plans**

- Please provide the office with any Medical Action Plans your child may have in place.
- Examples of, and blank, Medical Action Plans are available on the Pinewood Elementary School website.

- **Immunizations** – Information given at registration

- **Medications**

- Any over the counter or prescription medication must have a doctor's note in order for us to dispense to students.

- **Allergies**

- List all allergies your child may have on the medical forms you provide to the district.
  - Food, latex, bee stings, etc.

- **Absences**

- If your child is absent for any reason, please contact the front office.
